Title 1 support programs include parent and family involvement, counseling, health care, and other social services. In addition, certain educational programs are available to pupils who live in target areas and attend private schools and to neglected children who reside in institutions designated by the Texas Education Agency.

RESPONSIBILITIES

In order to become informed about law, parents and families are encouraged to attend the Title 1 Open House and to participate in each campus. Wilson Elementary will convene an annual meeting to inform parents and families of their schools participation in the Title 1 program, the requirements, and the parents' and families right to be involved. Through active participation, parents and families, teachers, and administrators share in the responsibility of improving student achievement for all students.

PARENT'S RIGHTS

Parents and families have the right to a copy of the law and an explanation of policy. Parents and families also have the right to give input into the development of the Title 1 program, its implementation and evaluation, and to have activities that are specifically designed to help them help their children improve their academic performance. The Every Student Succeeds Act requires parents and families of children who receive Title 1 services must be involved in the decisions regarding how these funds are allocated for family involvement activities.
