

Title 1

The Title I program is designed to meet the specific needs of the eligible children attending Austin Elementary. Title I programs are also designed to improve the educational opportunities of underachieving children and help them succeed in the regular program, attain grade level proficiency, and improve their achievement in the basic and more advanced skills.

Title I support programs include parent and family involvement, counseling, health care, and other social services. In addition, certain educational programs are available to pupils who live in target areas and attend private schools and to neglected children who reside in institutions designated by the Texas Education Agency.
