

## What is TITLE I?

The Title I program is designed to meet the specific needs of the eligible children attending Lamar Elementary. Title I programs are also designed to improve the educational opportunities of underachieving children and help them succeed in the regular program, attain grade level proficiency, and improve their achievement in the basic and more advanced skills.

Title I support programs include parental involvement, counseling, social/emotional learning, and other social services. In addition, certain educational programs are available to pupils who live in target areas and attend private schools and to neglected children who reside in institutions designated by the Texas Education Agency.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES**

In order to become informed about the law, parents are encouraged to attend the Title I parental involvement meetings and to participate in each campus. Through active participation, parents, teachers, and administrators share in the responsibility of improving students achievement for all students.

### **PARENT'S RIGHTS**

Parents have the right to a copy of the law Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) and an explanation of policy. Parents also have the right to contribute their input into the development of the Title I program, its implementation and evaluation, and to have activities that are specifically designed to help them help their children improve their academic performance. ESSA requires parents of children who receive Title I services to be involved in the decisions regarding how these funds are allocated for parental involvement activities.
