(Public Notification of Nondiscrimination in Career and Technical Education Programs)

Pampa ISD offers career and technical education programs in marketing, business, family consumer science, transportation, agricultural science, and industrial technology.

It is the policy of Pampa ISD not to discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, handicap, or age in its employment practices as required by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended; Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972; the Age Discrimination Act of 1975, as amended; and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended.

Pampa ISD will take steps to assure that lack of English language skills will not be a barrier to admission and participation in all educational and vocational programs.
